- View their cheques online with cheque imaging and view these cheques immediately following a debit on their account rather than waiting to receive their statement by mail at the end of the month
- Transfer funds to any other Caisse account
- Download banking operations in a financial planning software such as Quicken, Microsoft Money and Simply Accounting, or as a text file
- Pay anyone, anywhere, anytime, with just a name and address
- Make a mortgage or loan payment
- Postdate bill payments
- View a complete 2-year bill payment transaction history for budgeting – accessible anytime from any PC.

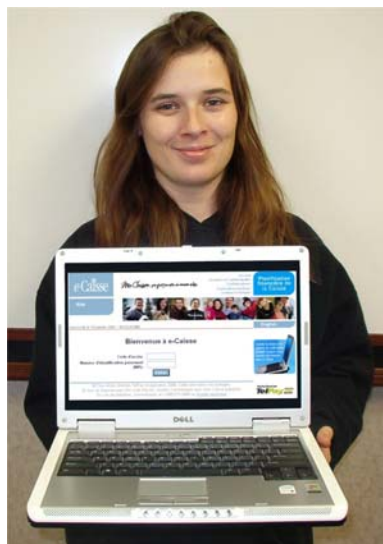
These banking services are fast and secure for all Manitoba Caisse members.

The Manitoba Caisse network, with consolidated assets of 654 M \$, is comprised of 7 separate and independant Caisses and 21 branches serving 30,700 members. Caisses are bilingual financial cooperatives.
